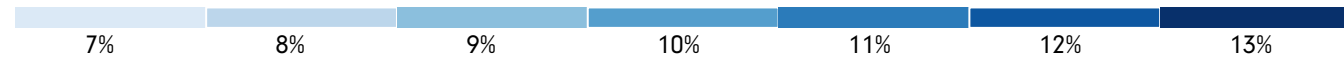
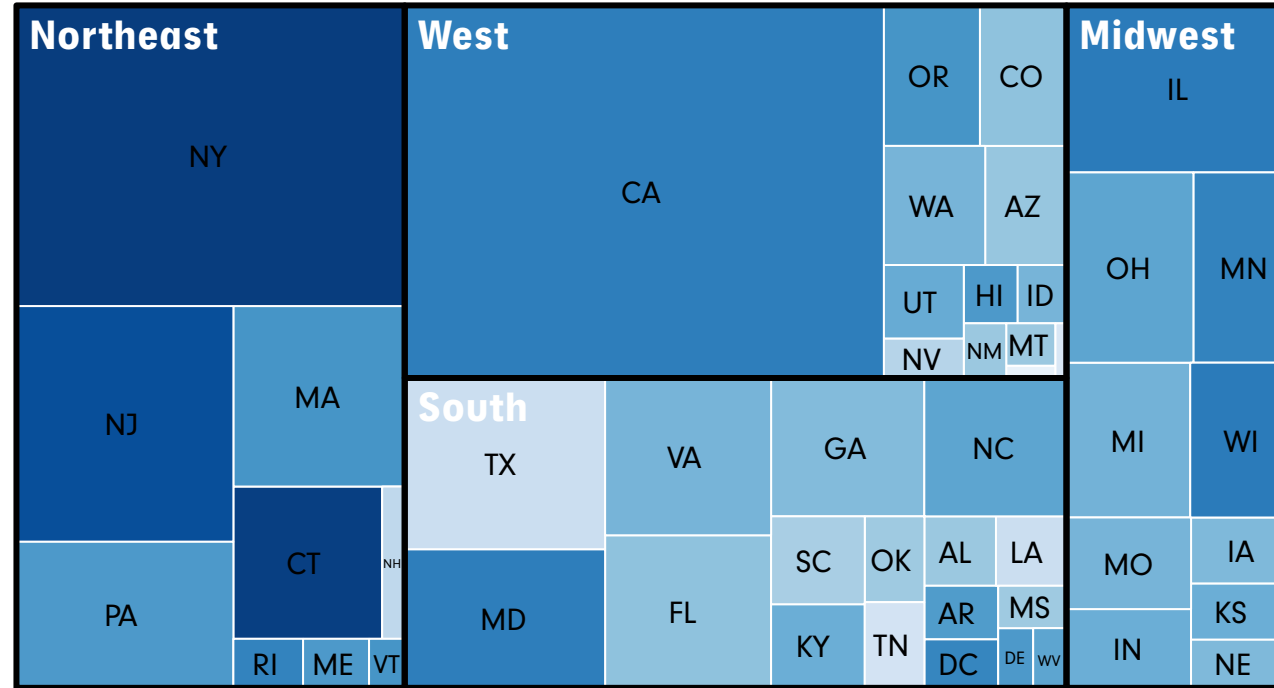


SALT Deductions Claimed by Each State as Percentage of Total

State and local tax deductions are claimed nationwide, but the amount differs by state. Below, each state's size is determined by the amount of SALT deductions claimed as a percentage of the national total. The color indicates the amount of taxes paid on average as a share of average income. Large states tend to claim more deductions, but small states with high taxes also punch above their weight (compare Florida and Connecticut, for example).
